

# Basic RiderCourse 2

## Skills Practice

***For individuals who already have their motorcycle license but want to "sharpen their skills."***

Program consists of 5 hours of training on your motorcycle in a controlled lot and under the watchful and helpful eye of a trained instructor.

### **The student must provide the following:**

1. Your own motorcycle registered to you.
2. Rider must have a minimum of six months riding experience.
3. Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian sign a release and waiver form before any riding exercises.
4. The following protective riding gear must be worn at all times during the actual riding portions of the course.
  - DOT-approved helmet
  - Over-the-ankle sturdy footwear
  - Full-finger gloves
  - Long-sleeved shirt or jacket
  - Long pants without holes -- preferably jeans
  - Eye protection
5. The operator of the motorcycle must have a motorcycle endorsement on their valid driver license.
